

WHITE

2023 Sauvignon Blanc Colombard, La Place. France, Gascogne (11% abv) *Fresh and crisp. The wine is fruity, offering citrusy aromas on the nose and a refreshing feel in the mouth.*

2023 Embrujo Verdejo Organic, Bodegas Verum. Spain, Castilla-La Mancha (12.5% abv) Dry, restrained Spanish white, hay and fennel flavours rounded out by plums and pears, ending on a restrained wash of citrus.

2023 Fiano IGT Terre Siciliane, Molino a Vento. Italy, Sicily (12.5% abv) Delicious Fiano, packed with tropical fruit, the bouquet a vibrant blend of refreshing lemon and spicy cedar.

2020 Sauvignon Blanc, Lionel Gosseaume. France, Loire (12.5% abv) *Bright citrus of grapefruits and white fruits. Fresh with roundness in the middle palate. Crisp and refreshing.*

2023 Les Mougeottes Chardonnay, IGP Pays d'Oc. France, Languedoc-Roussillon (13.5% abv) *Lemon and vanilla on the nose with a round, fruity body and a hint of vanilla oak.*

2023 Picpoul de Pinet Organic, Petit Roubie. France, Languedoc-Roussillon (12.5% abv) Bright, yet pale golden in colour. Wafts of sea-breeze mingle with delightful citrus, appleskin and herbs. Hints of peach and exotic fruits make a fleeting appearance too.

2022 Gavi di Gavi, La Minaia, Nicola Bergaglio. Italy, Piemonte (13% abv) Aromas of acacia and white peach, flicks the nose with wild herb, then settles on the tongue in a swirl of apple, lemon and melon.

2023 Not Your Grandma's Riesling, Chaffey Bros Wine Co. Australia, South Region (12.5% abv) Apples and orange blossom wash the tongue while the nose is seduced by flowers, lemon and lime...heady South Australian Riesling.

2022 Albarino, Martin Codax. Spain, Rías Baixas (12.5% abv) Intense and elegant with hints of fresh herbs, green apples, citric fruits and grapefruit. Rounded and full-bodied gives the wine an impressive sense of freshness.

2023 Greco di Tufo DOCG Devon, Caggiano. Italy, Campania (13.5% abv) Delicious, rounded white from southern Italy, bursting with tropical fruit and almond flowers and with a lick of limestone.

RED

2023 Varietal Cabernet Sauvignon, Tarapaca. Chile, Central Valley (13% abv) High intensity on red and dark fruits, with toasted hints of vainilla and coffee. Rich dark fruit flavours with a balanced acidity that blends perfectly with rounded tannins.

2022 La Place Merlot, IGP Pays d'Oc. France, Languedoc-Roussillon (13.5% abv) Soft and elegant with ripe damson fruit character, subtle tannin and a long elegant finish.

2022 Brunito Rosso Toscana IGT, Da Vinci. Italy, Tuscany (13.5% abv) A Tuscan red packed with cherries and raspberries, finishing with a perfumed note of spice.

2023 Remordimiento Red, Bodega Cerron. Spain, Jumilla (14% abv) Approachable red fruit, hints of aromatic herbs. Balanced, smooth palate, pure, refined flavors with mineral hints.

2022 Malbec, La Mascota. Argentina, Mendoza (14% abv) Intense and rich, packed with black fruits, both fresh and baked and freshened with a waft of liquorice and vanilla.



RED

2020 Bordeaux Superieur, Chateau Camarsac Vieilles Vignes. France, Bordeaux (13.5% abv) *Warm, spicy Bordeaux red, heady with cinnamon and clove, followed by a juicy mouthful of red and black fruit.*

2022 Valpolicella DOC, Bertani. Italy, Veneto (12.5% abv) Intense black currant, red plum, raspberry, black cherry and spice. On the palate the wine opens, fresh with a good balance between acidity, sweetness and tannin.

2021 Are You Game Pinot Noir, Fowles Wine. Australia, Victoria (13.5% abv) Delivering baskets of cherry and strawberry to the mouth, complemented by bracken, fresh earth and a touch of oak on the nose.

2016 Rioja Reserva, Sierra Cantabria. Spain, Rioja (14% abv) Full-bodied Rioja, packed with cherries and heady with flower petals, the whole given depth and seriousness by whiffs of tobacco, cedar and toasty oak.

2020 Saint Emilion Grand Cru, Chateau Eglise d'Armens. France, Bordeaux (13.5% abv *Silky Bordeaux, packed with red and black fruits, the nose an enticing cloud of herbs.*

ROSÉ

2023 Love by Leoube Organic Rose, Domaine de Leoube. France, Provence (12.5% abv) Dry and elegant Provence rosé: attractive red berries, wild flowers, melon and acacia. With vibrant acidity and a lovely finish, this is a wine to come back to again and again.

Brut Reserve 19 Chapel Down 6/75. England, Kent Aromas of red apple, citrus fruits and freshly baked bread, together with hints of strawberry and quince on the palate and fine persistent bubbles.

Rose Reserve NV Chapel Down 6/75. England, Kent Crisp, fresh and elegant, with notes of apple, light red berries and brioche.

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SPARKLING

NV Prosecco Brut Argeo, Ruggeri. Italy, Veneto (11% abv) *Delicate, zesty Prosecco, exuding green apples and citrus.*

2015 Blanc de Blancs, Artelium. England, Sussex (12% abv) A fresh, smooth style of Blanc de Blancs. Lemon citrus and cantaloupe melon fill the nose, with a medium-bodied and creamy textured palate.

2015 Vintage Brut, Taittinger. France, Champagne (12.5% abv) A cold winter followed by a hot, sunny summer has worked out well: this is mellow and full of Williams pears, greengages and Mirabelle plums, with honey on the finish.

NV Prestige Rose, Taittinger. France, Champagne (12.5% abv) This is both pretty and delicious, with a noseful of freshly crushed wild raspberries, cherries and blackcurrants and a balanced mouthful of red fruit.



SPARKLING

NV Brut Reserve, Taittinger. France, Champagne (12.5% abv) This is a crisp, citrussy sparkling wine with subtle notes of brioche and white flowers; in the mouth it is fruity, honeyed and moreish.

NV Cremant de Bourgogne Brut Grande Cuvee, Veuve Ambal. France, Burgundy (12% abv) Burgundian fizz, full of exotic fruit, balanced by a fresh wash of citrus; on the nose, the perfume of white flowers and a warm scent of fresh-baked pastries.

2023 Prosecco DOC Rose Treviso Argeo Brut, Ruggeri. Italy, Veneto (11.5% abv) Fresh, crisp northern Italian sparkling rosé, fizzing with cranberries and red fruit and with a light, yeasty, aroma of biscuit.

PORT&SWEET

2017 LBV Port, Quinta do Crasto. Portugal, Douro (20% abv) *Mellow, richly fruity Port that is dark ruby in colour with red fruit aromas and good concentration and length on the palate.*

2019 Tokaji Aszu 5 Puttonyos, Sauska. Hungary, Tokaji (11.5% abv) Rich in taste, very sweet but elegant too, with freshness and orange peel flavours. Aromas are dominated by dried tropical fruits such as apricot and mango, with a herbal hint.

2022 Sauternes Les Garonelles, Lucien Lurton. France, Bordeaux (13% abv) *Elegant Sauternes, heady with pineapple and mango, the tropicality finely balanced with citrus.*
